

Looking back, I see panoply of running, romping, giddy Salukis slide through my life in a rainbow of colors, and I am the richer for knowing them.

Whatever color or style I might surround myself with, when judging I see all coat types, colors, patterns, feathering as equal. Ours is a breed with a wide range of accepted sizes and shape, with an emphasis on moderate and functional structure.

Salukis were never bred to race around the show ring at a flying trot. Traditionally, our dogs were meant to hunt game at full gallop, and when seeking the game they might use a combination of maneuvers to sight and flush their quarry. They should be encouraged to carry themselves by light contact on the lead, at a speed which allows the opportunity to show themselves to best advantage. Loose lead, don't rush.

No matter how well our Salukis disport themselves in the ring, we cannot see what truly matters: their whimsical, engaging personalities, sly humor and deceptive naiveté, generally hiding a cunning mind. Whatever drew us to Salukis in the first place, whether it was the grace in motion or the keen eyed hunter, their unique personalities earned them a permanent place in our lives. The hunter in the field, the Saluki proceeding gravely around Agility obstacles, the high headed hound in the show ring with ears blowing in the wind of their passing...all of them go home to their own place on the couch and in our hearts. And we are the richer for knowing them.

When I am not stumbling through Agility courses with my 'luki buddies, or following them in the high plains fields, I'm writing about friends and relationships and dreams. I want to thank Central Arizona Saluki Association for inviting me to judge this prestigious event, bringing me back to good memories and cherished friendships. I look forward to sharing the day with friends and our beloved hounds.

My introduction to Afghan Hounds and dog shows began in 1968. Actual involvement and acquisition of our first Afghan was in 1970 along with my husband Hank Nave. Soon after came a Whippet and a Saluki. Our "first Afghan" BIS/SBIS Ch. Genesis Caelus of Jaffna became the number one Afghan in America with multiple Specialty and All Breed Best in Shows and a top producer. Since that time, there have been nine (10) other Best In Show winners bred and owned and over 100 AKC Champions. However, the accomplishment we are most proud of has been our stud dogs. They have produced nearly 200 champions including one of Americas Top Producers in America, Ch. Genesis Red Cloud with over 80 champions to his credit. Another Top Afghan we bred was BIS/SBIS Ch. Genesis Silver Charm; known as Brady. Brady was the number one Afghan in 1999 and 2000 and ranked in the top 10 Hounds until his tragic death in late 2000. We continued with Brady's daughter BIS/SBIS Shenandoah Pistol Blue, the Hound Group winners at the 2nd AKC/Eukanuba National Championship show in Orland, Florida. We are breeders at heart, we continue to breed or co-breed on a limited basis.

I exhibited the beautiful Saluki, Ch. Batal Cariad Maghar of Ariel, AKA; "Golda" back in the 1980's. "Golda" was owned by Lyndell Ackerman, Lou Guerrero, Hank Nave. Breeders; Mariyln Hodge & Carol Ciose.

I acquired my judging license for Afghans & Salukis in 1989 and now licensed to judge The Hound Group as well as Brittany's Chinese Cresteds, Italian Greyhounds, and all Poodle varieties, Junior Showmanship and Best In Show.

A member of Afghan Hound Club of California, past director of the Afghan Hound Club of America and is currently VP, show chairman for Western Hound Association of Southern California; AKA; The Hound Classic established in 1992, the First AKC approved hound group show in America.

I've judged in Australia, Canada, Finland, Germany Japan, Ireland, Italy, Mexico, New Zealand, and Sweden. And, had the honor to judge most of the Sighthounds at the 2008 Westminster Kennel Club.

I am very honored to have been asked to judge the Saluki League of Southern Arizona Specialty.

My kennel name is Awn and I have owned/bred Salukis since 1982. My bloodlines go back to old Dutch and English lines, Samoems and Burydown. My foundation Saluki was a male I imported from Samoems, BISS Am. Can. Ch. Samoems Shafquat, "Taxi", and all of my Salukis come down from him. I have also co-bred multiple times with Ingrid Romanowski, Firuza, in Canada and Felix van der Drift, Canapus, in Holland. Our Salukis are found in countries around the globe.

I am a member of SCOA and have served as chair of Breeder Referral, Nominating, Constitution & Bylaws, etc. I am currently chair of Judges Education. As a member of ASA, I have served as a VP and assistant editor. I am also a member of the North Texas Saluki Club and am currently on the board and ex-Pres.. Our club holds specialties and a party for everyone, each March. Please join us. I have belonged to NOFCA, TCC and the Southwest Coursing Club, having served as field clerk.

I open field coursed for many years and one of my Salukis achieved his NOFCA championship in only 9 hunt weekends, which is rare for an "out of area dog", as well as tieing for  $2^{nd}$  place in saluki competition at the NOFCA Grand Course. I had the first saluki who competed in open field coursing wearing a tracking wire on every hunt, a new design to locate your dog miles away. In saluki rescue, I was one of the founders in 1986 of National Saluki Rescue Network, the first national Saluki rescue organization. I have also written articles and researched for the ASA Newsletter, The Classic Saluki and Saluki International.

I began judging in 1997 and became fully licensed several years later. I am always thrilled to get the chance to judge this remarkable breed, with all of its variety and nuances. Salukis seem to me to be one of those truly extraordinary creations that steal your breath from time to time, as well as make you smile, so I am grateful they are part of my husband's and my life. Besides Salukis in the house and in the backyard, we help raise wild peacocks, along with some of our neighbors, in the front of the acreage. This means we have to be very careful when we open the backdoor as they sometimes wander back there if the dogs are not outside!

Thank you sincerely for inviting me to judge at your specialty, it is always an honor.

<u>COURSING:</u> for salukis that are AKC registered and are confirmed AKC or ASFA Field Champions, Coursing Champions or Coursers of Merit. Exhibitors must supply proof of title at time of entry. (A copy of the certificate awarding the title, or a copy of the entire page from either the AKC gazette or FAN magazine publishing the title, will be accepted as proof.) First place winners in this class are eligible for Best of Breed competition, providing all AKC eligibility requirements have been met, and providing dog is undefeated in any other class.

Winners of the above classes are eligible for Best of Breed competition.

# MULTIPLE DOG NON-REGULAR CLASSES

**STUD DOG CLASS:** For Stud dogs and no more than two (2) of their Get. Get must be entered in a regular class at this show. The award is based on the merit of the Get. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with the Get and be entered in this show. Stud Dog may be neutered. The owner of the Stud Dog does not need to be the owner of the Get. Stud Dog and Get comprise one entry.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS:** For Brood Bitches and no more than two (2) of their Produce. Produce must be entered in a regular class at this show. The award is based on the merit of the produce. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with the Produce and be entered in this show. Brood Bitch may be spayed. The owner of the Brood Bitch does not need to be the owner of the Produce. Brood Bitch and Produce comprise one entry.

**BRACE CLASS:** Shall be two (2) Salukis, regardless of sex, with at least ONE owner the same. At least one of the Brace must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed, or in a non-regular class other than Brace. Those desiring to show in Brace class must write "BRACE" on the entry form in the space provided for "Additional Classes". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated as "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc... Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered in this class.

**EXTENDED GENERATION CLASS:** Entry must be made up of a minimum of 3 generations of Salukis with one descendant from each successive generation, i.e. Dogs A, B, C. A is the sire/dam of B. B is the sire/dam of C. Only two representatives from each generation are allowed. Judge's decision is to be based on merit and likeness of Get/Produce. Off spring must be entered in a Regular Class, Non-Regular Class or Best of Breed competition. First place only will be awarded in this class. **A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog entered.** 

Winners of the above classes are not eligible for Best of Breed competition.

# **PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES**

Classes: Each age division is divided into dogs and bitches.

6 mos. & under 9 mos. 9 mos. & under 12 mos. 12 mos. and under 15 mos. 15 mos. and under 18 mos.

18 mos. and under 24 mos.

- 1. Entry fee is \$12.00
- 2. The Puppy Sweepstakes judging will take place before regular judging.
- 3. Dogs **MUST** be entered in a regular class.
- 4. Entries of champions are accepted.
- 5. Professional Handlers may only handle puppies of which they are registered owner or co-owner.
- 6. PRIZES: All entry fees for Puppy Sweepstakes will be divided as follows: 35% to be retained by Central AZ Saluki Club & Saluki League of Southern AZ. The remaining balance shall be divided:

 $1^{st}$  in class – 40%  $2^{nd}$  in class – 30%  $3^{rd}$  in class- 20%  $4^{th}$  in class-10%

Any unclaimed money will be awarded to the "Best Puppy" winner.

Cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person handling the dog which will be considered to be the rightful recipient of the award. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the sweepstakes judging is over. The show-giving club disclaims any liability for cash prizes after the judging is completed.

# **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES**

Classes: Each age division is divided into dogs and bitches.

7 years & under 9 years

9 years & under 11 years

#### 11 years and older

- 1. Entry fee is \$12.00.
- 2. The Veteran Sweepstake is open to all dogs 7 years and older.
- 3. The Veteran Sweepstake judging will take place before regular judging.
- 4. The dogs may be spayed or neutered.
- 5. Dogs DO NOT have to be entered in a regular class.
- Professional Handlers may only handle veterans of which they are registered owner or co-owner.
- 7. PRIZES: All entry fees for Veteran Sweepstakes will be divided as follows: 35% to be retained by Central AZ Saluki Club & Saluki League of Southern AZ. The remaining balance shall be divided:

 $1^{st}$  in class -40%  $2^{nd}$  in class -30%  $3^{rd}$  in class -20%  $4^{th}$  in class -10%

Any unclaimed money will be awarded to the "Best Veteran" winner.

Cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person handling the dog which will be considered to be the rightful recipient of the award. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the sweepstakes judging is over. The show-giving clubs disclaims any liability for cash prizes after the judging is completed.

## 4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY

One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for dogs that are four (4) months & under six (6) months on the day of the show. There will be a selection of 4-6 Month Best of Breed Beginner Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed Beginner Puppy.

An AKC registration number or litter number will be required for entries.

Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judge. Breed standard disqualifications such as color shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4-6 Month Puppy special attraction event.

Professional Handlers are not allowed to exhibit in this competition.

**Novice Junior:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior:** For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate:** For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Intermediate:** For boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition present in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior:** For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have not won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Senior:** For boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have won three first place awards with competition in the Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old on the day of the show, and who have won 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for the year has passed all participants return to the Open class for the following year.

#### **BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE**

**ALL JUNIOR HANDLERS ARE REQURED TO HAVE AN AKC NUMBER** PRIOR TO THE DAY OF THE EVENT. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club, call (919) 816-3776. Junior handlers must put their nine digit number on the entry blank. Be sure to include all information required on both the front and back of the official AKC entry form.




#### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

- 1. A recording fee of .50 cents per dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only.
- 2. Entries must reach show secretary, Kathy Hand, 315 S. 163<sup>rd</sup> St.., Gilbert, AZ., 85296, Wednesday, January 27, 2016, 7:00 PM MST. Fees must accompany entries.
- **3.** The club and/or Show Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
- **4.** The club and/or the Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class which the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly, or for entering the same dog twice. **No refunds of \$5.00 or less will be made.**
- 5. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry. There will be a \$4.00 fee charge for cancellation of entry prior to closing of entries.
- **6.** Foreign exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.
- 7. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee.

Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitor will result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check MUST BE MADE GOOD by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- **11**. Entries not on official AKC Entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies a condition to acceptance.
- 12. Owners are to have their dogs ready to go into the ring promptly, so judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only to be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler. Waiting for dogs is a courtesy extended to owners and handlers. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring.
- **13.** Owners must familiarize themselves with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books may be obtained from A.K.C., 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.

# **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS (continued)**

- 14. The Central Arizona Saluki Association and/or Saluki League of Southern Arizona, its Show Secretary or their employees will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- **15**. The Central Arizona Saluki Association and/or Saluki League of Southern Arizona does not agree to arbitrate claims set forth on official AKC entry form for this event.
- **16.** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest judging at the Show.
- **17**. There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.
- 18. Trophies, prizes and cash will be awarded in the judging ring before the completion of the classes and breed to the person showing the dog. The Show Secretary is to be advised at once, in the event of any discrepancy. The Show Secretary, The Central Arizona Saluki Association and/or Saluki League of Southern Arizona disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over. All trophies must be claimed the day of show. None will be mailed.
- **19**. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the club, its members or agents in the event a vehicle must be entered in order to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- 20. THIS IS A SELF CLEANING SHOW. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG
- **21.** The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at all times.
- 22. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.
- 23. Due to confined spaces, flexi-leads are not allowed.
- **24.** Violation of rules and regulations or inappropriate behavior toward Windemere Hotel employees, security staff, show committee, show officials or fellow exhibitors may subject participant in the event to disciplinary action by the show committee.




