## **Notice to Exhibitors**

1. Entries Close at 6:00 PM Wednesday, November 24, 2010 after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, changed or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11 Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules, and no entry fees will be refunded. There will be a \$2.00 fee charged for cancellation of an entry prior to the closing of entries.
  2. Entries not on Official AKC Forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. Entry Form must show the name of the Club and the date of show.
  3. Dogs need be present only for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be removed from the show grounds.
  4. It is advised that owners and agents be familiar with the Agreement on the reverse side of the entry form.
  5. To transfer a dog from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed Competition requires that the owner or agent notify the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the judging of the first class at this show.
  6. The entry forms in this premium list may be used for both shows. Please check the appropriate box of the show/shows you wish to enter your dog. This eliminates the need to fill out two entry forms for one dog.

## **Junior Showmanship Competition**

**Novice Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. The winner of the Novice class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

**Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes.** Each of the regular classes may be divided by age into Junior, Intermediate and Senior Classes, provided the division is specified in the premium list. A junior class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show. The Intermediate Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show. The Senior Class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the junior handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handlers household. Every dog entered in Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or in Obedience Trials. Bitches in season are not eligible. If a dog must be withdrawn for good reason, such as a bitch in season or a veterinarian's excuse, it may be replaced by another dog meeting the above requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All substitution requests must be made one half hour prior to the judging of any regular class at the show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class, with competition present, after the close of entries may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made with the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any judging at the show. The winner of a third First Place in a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible to enter in the corresponding Open Class at the show by notifying the Open Class ring steward, provided that there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in that Open Class.
